**MULTI-CHILD DISCOUNT (Tuition only)**

2<sup>nd</sup> Child- 5% discount

3<sup>rd</sup> Child- 10% discount

4<sup>th</sup> or more children- 20%

- Annual Payment Option #1- There will be a \*2% discount (tuition only) for those who pay the entire year's tuition on or before July 20 for the upcoming school year.
- Semi-Annual Payment Option #2 is paid by the semester. 1<sup>st</sup> payment due July 20, 2022. 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester Payment is due December 1. A \$28 service fee will be billed for this option.
- Monthly Payment Option #3- Tuition is divided into 10 equal payments. The 1<sup>st</sup> payment is due in July, and the last payment is due in April. Payments are made monthly via automatic bank draft through FACTS. A student's grades and/or report card, as well as all records will be withheld until all fees and/or fines are paid. An annual \$83 service fee will be billed on a monthly basis for this option.
- Providence Christian School accepts Florida Tax Credit Scholarships (FTC) including Step-Up for Students (SUFS) **on a limited basis**. To apply go to [www.stepupforstudents.org](http://www.stepupforstudents.org) to complete an application. Families are responsible for any money that SUFS does not cover.
- The Multi-child discount will be applied to according to the birth order of children in each family.

  - Additional fees apply for late pickup after 6:00 p.m. (\$1 per minute).
- To avoid late fees, Extended Care Fees must be paid by the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month.

- Elementary Books K5-6<sup>th</sup>- Book Fee will be billed in two monthly installments due on August 19, 2022 and September 20, 2022. Secondary Books 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>- Book Fee will due on September 20, 2022.
  - Secondary grade book lists, by grade, will be available in the School Office by NLT June 1, 2022. You may use these lists to get used books. Be sure to match ISBN #'s to ensure you purchase the correct edition.
  - All used books (secondary only) must be pre-approved for credit by August 5, 2022.
- Activity fee will be due September 20, 2022
- Technology Fee and Choir/Band Fee will be on September 20, 2022.
- Capital Improvement Fee will billed in two monthly installments due on October 20, 2022 and February 20, 2023.
- Athletic Team Fee will be billed at the beginning of each season.
- Graduation Fee will be billed February 1, 2023.
- School Polos Shirts can be purchased through the school office for \$20 a shirt, a PE outfit for \$25, School Outerwear for \$30 each, and used school uniforms for \$5 each.
- Other costs such as school uniforms and spirit shirts will be purchased separately.
- **All fees are due on the above dates and are non-refundable and are non-transferable.**

## ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL INFORMATION

- All pre-scheduled monthly payments will be drafted on your selected date (5<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> of the month) from a checking or savings account through the *FACTS Management Company*.
- Account statements are available online. Statements will be distributed monthly by the 5<sup>th</sup> business day of the month. It is important that the School Office has your correct home and email address on file.
- Please notify the Business Office of any statement discrepancies **within 10 days of receipt**. Additional detailed financial information can be obtained through the Business Office, in the School Handbook, or in enrollment paperwork.
- There will be a late charge of \$25 if account has not been paid by the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month.
- **If an account is past due more than thirty (30) calendar days, the parent will be notified and asked to remove the student from school unless adequate arrangements have been made with the Business Office.**

## WITHDRAWALS

- Parents withdrawing students from school must complete the withdrawal process through the school office before student is no longer considered a student of PCS. Accounts will be settled on a pro-rata basis based on date of withdrawal. **Students receiving Step Up For Students scholarships will be responsible for all fees not paid by the Florida Tax Credit Scholarship program.**
- Records will not be released or transferred if there is an outstanding balance due. Please see the Business Office for final account balance.
